

# Farm Map Portrait Requirements

## WHAT IS NEEDED

### House portrait

1. Take a photo from the angle you'd like the house to be drawn. This will be the main reference for the portrait, so pick the side that best represents your home.
2. A wide-angle shot (or multiple overlapping photos) that shows the yard, garden, trees, fences, or driveway helps add context and atmosphere to the portrait.

### Farm Map

1. A screenshot of the land from Google Maps, along with any relevant information you would like to include.
2. If possible, please provide the postcode so I can zoom in and clarify any details.

## SAMPLE FARM MAP

Simply mark the land boundaries and label the fields with names and numbers, as illustrated below. Don't worry, they don't have to be perfectly straight lines!
